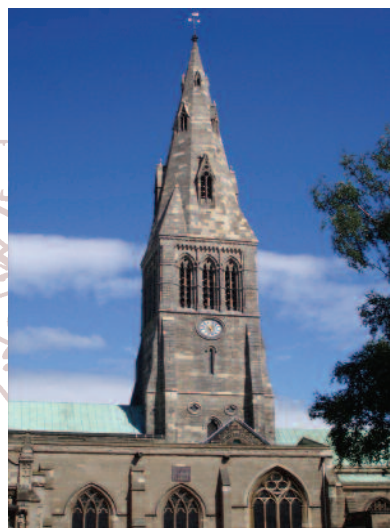

Festival Finale Sunday 19th September 2010 7.30 pm

Once again the Festival concludes in the candlelit setting of Leicester's splendid cathedral with some of the most beautiful music ever written. A contemplative first half will include music by four of this year's five composers, while the second half will feature one of the most moving works of all time, Schubert's exquisite String Quintet. And there is an extra treat! With generous funding from the Britten-Pears Foundation, the Festival has been able to commission a new work for oboe d'amore and string quartet from our composer in residence John Woolrich, which will be given its world première in this concert.
